THIS WEEK'S LESSON: MR. OBEDIENT



IN THE CAR:

Ask your child what they learned about this week on the drive home:
God asked Abram (who became Abraham) to move to a new place and Abraham obeyed immediately. Kids will learn that having faith means we obey God.



M HANGING OUT:

Make this week's lesson real:

Encourage your kids to practice listening and responding the first time this week. Be sure to model this yourself. If your kids ask for help with something, do it the first time. Show them how to not only respond but be good listeners so they can respond quickly.



AT DINNER:

Here are some great discussion starters:

- What did God ask Abram to do?
- Why didn't Abram question God when he asked him to move?
- How can we be more obedient to God?



AT BEDTIME:

Quiz your child on this week's memory verse:

"Faith is confidence in things that we hope for and assurance of the things we cannot see on our own" Hebrews 11 vs 1



PARENT TIME:

What you need to know:

If we have faith, we will obey God's direction. We will trust him enough to follow him and to follow the first time he asks. Is there some area in your life where you are not being obedient? Give it to God, and ask God to give you an obedient heart.
